Call to order:

We have about \$175k in our account. We earned a few dollars in interest during the month.

We received from the state more than \$50k in July for the second quarter. This continues the trend of increasing amounts from prior quarters.

The solicitor's bill for the second quarter of about \$2500 is payable.

Frank and Stefan received QuickBooks online training for which we owe about \$25.

We'd like to buy the rights to "dcigra.org" (and dcigra.com for redirecting) and a few related email addresses for which there will be a small annual charge.

Old Business.

We approved the open records policy.

We approved the RFP for a website.

New Business.

We elected Frances Sheehan as our Open Records Exception Officer.
